LOWRY, John b. ca. 1740 d. 1817 Battle Creek Valley

Battle Creek Valley Homeplace. Owned an Inn called “**Lowry’s Place**”

Owned & operated **Lowry’s Ferry** @ TN river & mouth of Battle Ck.

Owned a stock & cattle business

Under the **Calhoun** Treaty in 1819 reservations were given to **John Lowry’s widow** and descendants.

The 12 Cherokee Indian 640 acre Reservations

“Lowry Dynasty”

Located in “now Marion Co., Tennessee”

LOWRY, George b. 1770 d. 1852 Oklahoma . A 640 acre Reservation located between Reservations of **Pidgeon & Peggy Shory** on Battle Creek.

LOWRY, Elizabeth Shory

A 640 acre Reservation on Battle Creek joining that of **Peggy Shory** on the west and extending south to include **Lowry’s** Ferry on the North side of the Tennessee River and below the lower end of Burns Island. (**Lowry’s** Island).Crosses the Georgia road and Battle Creek.

LOWRY, James

A 640 acre Reservation on Battle Creek. (designated as place formerly occupied by **Crow Mocker**, now Kimbal, TN.) **James Lowry** property joined that of his sister, **Susannah Lowry** on the east.

LOWRY, SUSANNAH

A 640 acre Reservation on Battle Creek, joining the property of **James Lowry** on the West, **Robert McLeamores** line on the bank of Battle Creek, to the foot of the mountain crossing the fork of Battle Creek known by the name of the Firey Gizzard. Including the tole bridge and Battle Creek in the center.

SHOREY, Peggy

A 640 acre Reservation on Battle Creek located south of the Reservation of **George Lowry** and joining that of **Elizabeth Shory Lowry** on the east.

McLEMORE, Robert

Battle Creek – A 640 acre Reservation joining the Reservation of **Susannah Lowry** on the north and extending south from the mouth of Firey Gizzard Creek.

PIDGEON

A 640 Acre Reservation on Battle Creek, located south of the Cherokee Reservation of **Robert McLemore**.

NANCY GOARD

A 640 acre Reservation on Battle Creek and north side of Tennessee River.
Including the mouth of Battle Creek.

EIGHT KILLER

A 640 acre Reservation on the Firey Gizzard, north of the Cherokee Reservation of **Susannah Lowry**.

PACK, ELIZABETH LOWRY “Betsy”

Battle Creek. A 640 acre Reservation east of Battle Creek in the area of presently occupied by the City of Jasper, Marion Co., Tennessee. [North side TN river crossing Georgia Road, & Town Spring]
(Betsy deeded 40 acres for the County Court House and Town site of Jasper in 1919.)

HOLT, Eli M.

Running Water – A 640 acre Cherokee Reservation at Running Water Town obtain by Holt “in right of his wife” in 1818.

WALKER, John, Jr.

Running Water – A 640 acre Cherokee Reservation on the Tennessee River opposite the mouth of Running Water Creek. (North side of River)

Battle Creek – Individual enrolled for emigration October 16, 1818. But did not go

GEORGE

Battle Creek – Individual. Enrolled for emigration November 27, 1818.

GOOSE LANGLEY

Battle Creek – 2 persons in family. Enrolled for emigration February 15, 1819. But did not go.

HUNTER LANGLEY

Battle Creek – 3 persons in family. Enrolled for emigration October 29, 1818. But did not go.

JOHN JUSTICE

Battle Creek – 3 persons in family. Enrolled for emigration October 29, 1818. But did not go

LOONEY, Tuskee

Battle Creek 9 persons in family. Enrolled for emigration May 14, 1818.

NOON DAY

Battle Creek – Individual Enrolled for emigration November 27, 1818. But did not go.

OO-LOO-CHEE

Battle Creek – 2 persons in family. (widow) Enrolled for emigration November 16, 1818.

THE EAGLE

Battle Creek – 6 persons in Family. Enrolled for emigration October 15, 1818.

WIND BLOWING

Battle Creek – 4 persons in family. Enrolled for emigration October 30, 1818. But did not go.

YOUNG CHICKEN

Battle Creek – 3 persons in family. Enrolled for emigration December 16, 1818. But did not go.

Long Island

Located on the Tennessee River & Alabama State Line of Marion Co., TN.

THE BAG

Long Island – 2 persons in family. Enrolled for emigration November 12, 1818.

Lowry Island (Now Burns Island)
Lowry Island located in the Tennessee River, above the mouth of Battle Creek.

LOWRY, John

Owned & operated **Lowrys** Ferry on the Tennessee river at the mouth of Battle Creek.

Running Water Town was located on the Tennessee River in Marion Co.,TN.
It is now partly inundated by the Nickajack Lake.

AH-CHI-LLA, son of OLD CHIEF GLASS.

Running Water – Individual. Enrolled for emigration August 23, 1818.

AUTOE Running Water – 5 persons in family. Enrolled for emigration May 19, 1818.

BALDRIDGE, George Running Water – 9 in family. Enrolled for emigration May 19, 1818. Did not go.

BEAVER or **CHA-LAG-A-TEE** Running Water – 3 in family. Enrolled for emigration May 19, 1818.

BOGGS, Widow Running Water – 7 persons in family. Widow enrolled for emigration November 15, 1818.

BUFFALO BELLOWING Running Water – 2 in family. Enrolled for emigration October 27, 1818.

CANOE BREAKER Running Water – 6 persons in family. Enrolled for emigration May 19, 1818.

CAT Running Water – 2 persons in family. Enrolled for emigration May 28, 1818.

CHA-LAKEE-TE-HEE Running Water – 5 in family. Enrolled for emigration May 30, 1818. Did not go.

CHE-CHE-HAL-QUAH Running Water – Individual. Enrolled for emigration December 16, 1818.

CHEE-ENNA-NEE Running Water – 6 in family. She is widow. Enrolled for emigration May 23, 1818.

COTA-KYO-WAY Running Water – Individual. She is a widow. Enrolled for emigration October 28, 1818.

COTAN-NAH Running Water – Individual. She is a widow. Enrolled for emigration October 28, 1818.

COUA-YOW-KAH Running Water – Individual. She is a widow. Enrolled for emigration October 28, 1818.

ECULLAH or MERIDIAN Running Water – Individual. Enrolled for emigration May 19, 1818.

GROUND SQUIRREL Running Water – Individual. Enrolled for Emigration October 27, 1818.

HEAD BOILER Running Water – 6 persons in family. Enrolled for emigration May 19, 1818. Did not go.

HOLT, James Running Water – Individual. Enrolled for Emigration October 27, 1818.

KAN-TA-KEE Running Water – 7 persons in family. Widow. Enrolled for emigration November 15, 1818.

PATH KILLER Running Water. Individual. Enrolled for emigration October 27, 1818.

QUALA-YOO-KA

Running Water – 3 persons in family. She is a widow. Enrolled for emigration on May 23, 1818.

RACoon Running Water – Individual. Enrolled for emigration July 30, 1818, but did not go.

SIT-LA-WA-KE Running Water – Individual. Enrolled for emigration October 27, 1818.

SMOKE Running Water – Individual. Enrolled for emigration October 27, 1818.

SQUIRREL Running Water – Individual. Enrolled for emigration May 20, 1818.

SUSANNAH Running Water – Individual. She is a widow. Enrolled for emigration October 28, 1818.

SWIMMER Running Water – 3 persons in family. Enrolled for emigration May 24, 1818.

TA-QUALA-LOO or WAGGON

Running Water – Individual. Enrolled for emigration August 23, 1818, but did not go.

THE TASSEL (a youth) Running Water. Individual. Enrolled for emigration October 27, 1818.

UNA-NOO-TEE Running Water. Individual. Enrolled for emigration August 11, 1818, but did not go.

YOUNG FOX Running Water – Individual. Enrolled for Emigration October 27, 1818.

YOUNG GLASS 2nd. Running Water - 7 persons enrolled for emigration January 12, 1818.

YOUNG PUPPY Running Water – 2 persons in family. Enrolled for emigration May 19, 1818.

YOUNG WOLF Running Water – Individual. Enrolled for emigration October 27, 1818. Did not go.

Located on the Tennessee River in Marion Co., TN.
(now inundated by Nickajack Lake.)*

CHICKASAW TEE-HEE

Nickajack – 3 persons in family. Enrolled for emigration August 10, 1818.

GEORGE

Nickajack – 9 persons in family. Enrolled for emigration May 22, 1818.

OO-KOL-LO-KA (a youth)

Nickajack – Individual. Enrolled for emigration August 14, 1818. Did not go.

OO-TO-LON-AH

Nickajack – Individual. Enrolled for emigration August 14, 1818, but did not go.

SKON-TEE-AH

Nickajack – Individual. Enrolled for emigration August 14, 1818. But did not go.

TAH-LAN-TAS-TAH

Nickajack – Individual. Enrolled for emigration August 14, 1818. Did not go.

YE-WE-CA-NAH-KA

Nickajack – 5 persons in family. Enrolled for emigration September 10, 1818. Did not go.
