

THE TWO RUSSELL BROWNS OF EARLY GRUNDY COUNTY HISTORY

Researchers sometimes confuse these two Russell BROWNS, so here is some data on each of them.

The older Russell BROWN was born about 1806 and, according to "Beersheba Springs - A History", was the son of Absolom and Mary Jane (GREEN) BROWN. He married Mary ("Polly") DYKES, daughter of Isham, Jr. and Prudence (CHOATE) DYKES. Their family in the 1840 census: 3 males, 0 to 15 years old; 1 male, 40 to 50 years old; 2 females, 0 to 10 years old; 1 female, 20 to 30 years old. Later census records:

The children of Russell and Mary (DYKES) BROWN as found in "Beersheba Springs A History" and census, marriage and cemetery records:

1. Asbury, born c1830, married Mary ("Polly") MORTON and in 1860, Warren County: Asbury, 32; Mary, 32; Stephen, 11; Mahala, 8; Charles, 5; Richard, 2; Mary, 2 mos.
2. Hortensia, born c1832, married James CAGLE.
3. John G., born c 1835, married 1st Sallie JOHNSON, 2nd Azalee MOFFITT GROSS.
4. Julia Ann, born Mar 1838, married A. J. SMITH, 13 Feb 1859. In 1860, Julia Ann is 21, living with her parents and has son, James, 6 months old. On 8 June 1862, Warren County, Julia Ann married Sanders DYKES, son of Martin DYKES. They lived in Grundy, Sequatchie and Marion Counties. Known children were: John, Elijah, Jennie, Isham, Prudence, Mark, Lawrence, Thomas and Jake.

The children of Russell and Mary (DYKES) BROWN cont'd:

5. Isham S., born c1840, is not found after the 1860 census. Beersheba Springs History says he was killed in the Civil War.
6. Prudence, born c1841-44, married John HOBBS, 13 Mar 1860. In 1880 census, John is 40 and Prudy is 39.
7. Thomas J., born June 1847, married Nancy GROSS, 15 Aug 1869. In 1880, they have children, Isham and Mary. In 1900, Thomas J. is 53; Nancy E., born Jul 1850, is 49, had 4 children with 2 living.
8. Aurena E., born 1848-50.
9. James K. Polk, born Dec 1854, married 22 Dec 1875, Elizabeth SMITH, probably daughter of Eli J. and Ann SMITH. From the 1900 and 1910 censuses, they have children: Lula L., born Jul 1887; Ashley, born Jul 1891; Eli J., born Sep 1895; Francis R., born Aug 1899; Jasper E., which may be the same as Elmer born c1903. Ashley married Ethel SMITH, 29 Jan 1910.
10. Frances, buried Morton Cemetery, 25 Dec 1855/8 Jul 1898, married William Taylor DUGAN, 11 Aug 1870. He was son of John and Louisa (WALKER) DUGAN. The 1880 census gives children as J. Russell and Prudy L. Beersheba Springs History adds Ira, Walter and Frank.

Brown Cemetery, Warren County: Russell, 16 Sep 1801/26 Oct 1852, son of Absolom and Mary Jane (GREEN) BROWN, husband of Mary DYKES.

The younger Russell BROWN was born Oct 1842, the son of Rev. William Sanford and Nancy (DYKES) BROWN and a nephew of Russell born c1806. Warren County historian, Thomas J. BARNES gives the 1st wife of Russell as Elizabeth TATE, born c1846, daughter of Samuel Jackson TATE. In the 1870 census, Russell L., 28, is living at home. Other census records:

No record was found of Russell's marriage to Elisabeth TATE or to Mary (TATE) NUNLEY. Mary was daughter of Francis Marion and Mary (BOST) TATE and widow of John NUNLEY. Mary was born Oct 20, 1852 and died Jun 21, 1907 and is buried as Mary L. NUNLEY, Hobbs Hill Cemetery. On 19 Nov 1907, Russell married Jamie (LOCKHART) LOCKHART, widow of James M. LOCKHART, and daughter of Holman and Nancy (HUNTER) LOCKHART.

According to "Beersheba Springs - A History", the Thomas Jefferson BARNES Papers, and census records, these are the children of Russell and Elisabeth (TATE) BROWN:

1. Margaret, daughter of R. L. and Elisabeth BROWN, 20 Oct 1866/21 Oct 1866, Brown's Chapel Cemetery.
2. William Franklin, son of R. L. and Elizabeth BROWN, 27 Jul 1867/30 Sep 1867, Brown's Chapel Cemetery.
3. James born c1869, in the 1880 census, is probably the same son as called Jim Jackson BROWN in BARNES Papers. No more is found on him.
4. Nancy Ann, in census records, seems to have been born Jan 1871. She was second wife of William Carroll PARSONS. Their children may have been Era, Skelton and Harvey. Nancy Ann PARSONS is buried in Tracy City Cemetery: 1872-1935. William Carroll is buried in Orange Hill Cemetery besides his first wife, Louisa DYKES PARSONS.
5. Laura, born Apr 1874, married John SLOAN, 8 Jun 1892. In Hobbs Hill Cemetery: Laura J. SLOAN, Apr 16, 1874/(blank); John L. SLOAN, Sep 17, 1870/Apr 4, 1954.
6. Victor, born c 1878, married Mary BROWN. Nothing more found.
7. Abbie, born Mar 1881, married Charles P. SWEETON, 20 Dec 1899. Their children thru the 1920 census: Douglas, Marshall, Lyle, Libbie and Carl. In Hobbs Hill Cemetery: Abbie D. SWEETON, 10 Mar 1881/15 Jul 1957; Charles P. SWEETON, 1875-1942.
8. Noah, born 1883, married 1st Susie HENDERSON, 20 Feb 1902, and 2nd Nannie SCRUGGS, 15 Sep 1907. Was Susie the daughter of Samuel C. HENDERSON, 62, widower, in 1900, with daughter Susan C., born Oct 1872? In Hobbs Hill Cemetery: Susie HENDERSON BROWN, wife of Noah, 1 Oct 1875/20 May 1906. In 1910, Noah and Nannie have daughter, Elois May, 1. Children in 1920: Russell, 16; James, 8; Louease, 6; Dora E., 1. Hobbs Hill Cemetery: Noah Alden BROWN, 3 Nov 1883/23 Apr 1971; Nancy Jane SCRUGGS BROWN, 3 Dec 1882/1 Mar 1960. (Nancy Jane probably daughter of James E. and Annie (SCHILD) SCRUGGS.)

In 1910, Russell BROWN has step-grandchild, Paul HENDERSON, in his family. Is this the same Paul, called son, by Samuel C. HENDERSON, in 1900? When Samuel's daughter, Susan, married Noah BROWN, did Paul become Noah's step-son and Russell's step-grandchild? Who was Paul's mother? Susan?

Brown's Chapel Cemetery, Grundy County: R. L. BROWN, 1842-1932.

Three of the children of Absolom and Mary Jane (GREEN) BROWN:

- A. Permelia married John Goolman TATE, daughter of James and Ruth TATE.
 - a. Daughter, Elizabeth, b. 1842, married Isham DYKES, Jr., son of Isham, Sr., and Prudence (CHOATE) DYKES.
- B. Russell, born c1806, married Mary (Polly) DYKES, daughter of Isham, Sr., and Prudence (CHOATE) DYKES.
 - b. Their daughter, Julia, married Sanders DYKES, son of Martin DYKES.
- C. William Sanford married Nancy DYKES, daughter of Isham, Sr., and Prudence (CHOATE) DYKES.
 - c. Their son, Russell, born c1842, married 1st Elisabeth TATE, day of Samuel Jackson TATE. Children believed to be: Margaret, William Franklin, James, Nancy Ann, Laura, Victor, Abbie, and Noah.
 Russell married 2nd Mary (TATE) NUNLEY, daughter of Francis Marion and Mary (BOST) TATE, and widow of John NUNLEY. Russell became step-father to Burton, Alexander, Della, Maggie, William F., and Leonard NUNLEY. Mary became step-mother to the children of Russell and Elizabeth (TATE), named above.

B.b. is the line being researched by Mrs. Sherry Quinn, 17W321 Birnam Trail, Hinsdale, IL 60521-6010. Sherry is looking for parents of Virginia T. DYKES, born 1867, TN, who married Benjamin J. DOVE, in 1881, in Jasper. In 1880, Sequatchie County, Sanders and Julia (BROWN) DYKES have a daughter, Jennie, 12, (born c1868), and, in 1900, Marion County, Sanders and Julia and their sons, Thomas and Mark with their families, live adjacent to or very near Benjamin and Virginia DOVE, possibly indicates relationship.

C.c. is the line being researched by Mrs. Linda Nunley Brown, 9705 SW 194th Circle, Dunnellon, FL 34432, but she is interested in Russell Brown only as a step-relative (if there is such a thing!). Her great grandfather, John NUNLEY married Mary ("Duck") TATE, 1873, Grundy County. John NUNLEY died c1887 and his widow married Russell BROWN. She died 1907 and is buried Hobbs Hill Cemetery as Mary L. NUNLEY. Why is she not buried as Mary L. BROWN? Russell BROWN married 3rd Jamie LOCKHART, Nov. 1907.

Julia Ann, b. 1838, was dau of Russell BROWN and Mary (Polly)(DYKES) BROWN. She married A. J. SMITH, 13 Feb 1859 and, in 1860, is living with her widowed mother and has a 6 months old son, James. On 8 June 1862, Warren County, Julia BROWN md. Sanders DYKES. In 1870, James, 11 yrs old, is assumed to be James SMITH. Is Louisa J, age 4, the same person as Jennie who is 12 in 1880? Who is Louisa DYKES, 1866-1890, buried besides William Carroll PARSONS, in Orange Hill Cemetery?

In 1900, Julia Ann said she had had 10 children. From census records: James, John, Elijah, Louisa/Jennie, Isham, Prudence, Mark, Lawrence, Thomas and Jake. In that census, these families are listed in adjacent houses:
 (1) Sanders, 83; Julia A., 62; Jake, 19. (2) Thomas DYKES, 22; Lydia, 25; Lillie, 3; Delia, 1. (3) Ben J. DOVE, 48; Virginia T., 33; Pearl, 13; Jas. W. Mc., 10; Virginia, 6; Avery, 4; Viola, 1. (4) Mark DYKES, 27; Alice, 24; Grover, 8; Mattie, 5; Icie, 4 mos. This seems to indicate that the DOVES are a part of this DYKES family.

"Beersheba Springs - A History" says Alexander was son of William NUNLEY, b. 1794, married Jean MILLER. Alexander, born 1823, married Bettie HOBBS. Their children are given as: Sarah, married Reuben SMARTT; Jesse, married June SMARTT; John, married "Duck" TATE, dau of Polly BOST TATE; William E., married Ada, dau of Polly BOST TATE.

Information on known children:

Jesse - "Beersheba Springs" says he married June, daughter of John SMARTT.

John - From descendant, Linda NUNLEY BROWN: John, born 4 May 1850, died 11 Jun 1887?, married Mary L. TATE, born 20 Oct 1852, died 21 Jun 1907, buried Hobbs Hill Cemetery, believed to be Mary ("Duck") TATE, daughter of Francis Marion and Mary ("Polly") BOST TATE. Marriage was 30 Apr 1873.

Children of Mary L. and John NUNLEY:

- (a) Burton, b. c1874, married Samuel DISHROON and in 1910, they have children: Norman, Gladis, John E., and Sam E. The Dishroons moved to Illinois.
- (b) Alexander, called "Zander", born c1876, is in 1900 living with his mother and step-father, Mary (TATE) NUNLEY and Russell BROWN. Married Maggie HENDERSON, 1-26-1902.
- (c) Maggie, born Jan 1878, married Sanford BROWN, 9-12-1897. Their children were Ethleen, Carl David, Sanford, and Margaret.
- (d) Della, born May 1879, married Milton LOCKHART, 8-8-1900. He was son of Andrew J. and Elizabeth R. LOCKHART. In Hobbs Hill Cemetery, Della N. LOCKHART, May 5, 1879/Jan 3, 1902.
- (e) William F., born 31 Jan 1881, married Nellie Pirtle HAMPTON, 5-23-1900. In 1910, they have Hazel, Harvey, and Alvin. In 1912, they had Earl Joseph.
- (f) Leonard B., 10 Nov 1883/6 Dec 1921, buried Hobbs Hill Cemetery, married E. Lois HAMPTON, 30 Jun 1895/7 Nov 1974. Their children were Violet Elixabeth md Arthur J. JORDAN; Leonard E.; Opal May md John LETFORD; Ada Virginia md 1st Howard LEE, 2nd Guy MOSER, 3rd Theodore REISTER. Parents of E. Lois were Charles Russell and Ada (SEWELL) HAMPTON.

Sarah - Born Aug 1852, married Reuben SMARTT, 3-13-1869, son of William C. and Esther GREEN SMARTT.

- (a) Frances Marion, married Myra NUNLEY, 1-26-1899. In 1910 Frances M. is a widower with son, Paul, 6.
- (b) Henry C., born Jul 1877, married Esther BESS, 7-27-1907. In 1910, their family is Lillian, dau, 7, and Eloder BESS, 9. Other children, 1920: Nellie, Burton, Wallace, Lucinda.
- (c) Benjamin Franklin, born Aug 1878, married Lucy, dau of Christopher and Elizabeth (SMITH) HOBBS and 1st wife of Frank Cheatum NORTH CUTT. In Hebron Cemetery, Warren County: Frank, 1878-1940; Lucy, 15 Sep 1871/22 Dec 1944. In 1920, their children were Marcus, Lizzie, Lassie, Lemar.
- (d) Lyman Beecher, 20 Dec 1882/Jul 12, 1961, buried Mormon Church Cemetery, Northcutt's Cove, married Flossie TIPTON, 12-23-1905. She was born 25 Dec 1885, daughter of John H. and Bell TIPTON. Their children in 1920: Ora, Geneva, Jessie, Reed, Avis, and Philander.
- (e) Olive, born May 1884, said to have married Arnold SMARTT.
- (f) Alfred T., born Jan 1887, never married.
- (g) Louie (female), born Sep 1889, never married.
- (h) James B., born June 1891, married Vivian BROWN, 5-21-1916. She may have been dau of John O. and Hattie (WALKER) BROWN. In 1920, James and Vivian have children: Sidney, 2, and Kernol, 11 mos.
- (i) Thomas R., born Nov 1893, never married. He was a well-known mail carrier in Grundy County.

William E. - Born Sep 1853 (or '55), married Martha Ada TATE, dau of Francis Marion and Mary "Polly" BOST TATE, sister of Mary L. TATE who married John NUNLEY.

Known children of William E. and Martha Ada:

- (a) Martha, Hobbs Hill Cemetery: 9-13-1886/7-30-1896.
- (b) Harris, born Jan 1876, married Mary Bell _____. Children in census records: Harold, Hollis, and Isabelle. In Hobbs Hill Cemetery: Harris NUNLEY, Jan 24, 1876/Feb 29, 1943; Mary Bell NUNLEY, 26 Jan 1878/_____.
- (c) Emma, born Jan 1880, married Joseph GEARY, 12-20-1899. In 1900, Joseph is 21, Emma is 20 and living with them is William F. NUNLEY, 19, and wife, Nellie HAMPTON NUNLEY, 17. William F. is son of John and Mary TATE NUNLEY and cousin to Emma.

- (d) Mary, born Mar 1883.
- (e) Albert S., born Apr 1884, married Maude BROWN, 12-6-1903. Their children, from "Beersheba Springs - A History" were Ralph, Kathleen, Agnes, Stanley, Barton, Betty, and Glen. In Palmer Cemetery, Albert S., Apr 2, 1884/Sep 14, 1973; Maud B., Nov 25, 1887/_____.
- (f) Martha A., Hobbs Hill Cemetery: Martha NUNLEY, 13 Sep 1886/30 Jul 1896.
- (g) William H., born Jan 1890. Possibly called Henry and buried with family of W. E. NUNLEY, in Hobbs Hill Cemetery: Henry, 1890-1932.
- (h) Charles C., born Mar 1892, seems to be the Clarence who married Josie PATRICK, 2 Jan 1915. In 1920, Clarence is 27 and Josie is 26. In Fall Creek Cemetery: C. Clarence PATRICK, 1892-1949; Josephine L., 1893/_____.
- (i) Luther, born Apr 1894, is at home with his parents in 1920. He is buried in Hobbs Hill Cemetery: L. A., 1894-1951.
- (j) Hilda, born Jun 1898, married John PATRICK, 26 Jul 1914. In most records he is called Isham. He and sister, Josie who married C. Clarence NUNLEY, were children of Rachel PATRICK, 40, widow, in 1910. In 1920, Hilda and Isham have daughter, Lena, 1 yr old. In Fall Creek Cemetery: Hilda G. PATRICK, 16 Jun 1898/29 Dec 1950; Isham, 9 Mar 1891/29 Jan 1941.
